Please note:

Several times, the FEI Endurance Committee promised, that future Senior Championships will be held over 160 km/ 1 day. It was said that the European Championship 2003, Punchestown- IRL (supposed to be held over 200 km/ 2 days) is to be considered as a one time exception. But in the above published "Categories of Endurance Events", *CEI***** with regard to Senior Championships are still declared as follows:
