

  - with a different course and new organisational structure




















# **Building Measures / Stadium 2**




















## **Building Measures / Stables and Veterinary Centre**

- total permanent stable capacity: then 365 boxes
























#### **Hotel Accommodation**



- Cooperation with the Aachen Tourist Office as Official Hotel Reservation Partner for the WEG Aachen 2006.
- Hotel Pool:
  - 1,470 rooms in Aachen City
    - of which 1,250 have been booked by OC for team members, officials, journalists, etc.
  - 7,426 rooms in total (max. distance 70 km)
    - of which more than 800 have already been booked
- Aachen Tourist Office offers online booking (www.aachen2006.com) for non-team members.


















#### **Hotel Accommodation**

- Teams
  - all NFs have been informed about the preliminary hotel capacity (max.) reserved by the OC for their teams (Feb.05)
- "Vaulting-Village"
  - vaulting teams will be accommodated in army barracks in Aachen
- Grooms
  - will be accommodated in the indoor hockey arena, right next door to the show grounds/stable area; 2 persons per room, total capacity of approximately 150 beds











